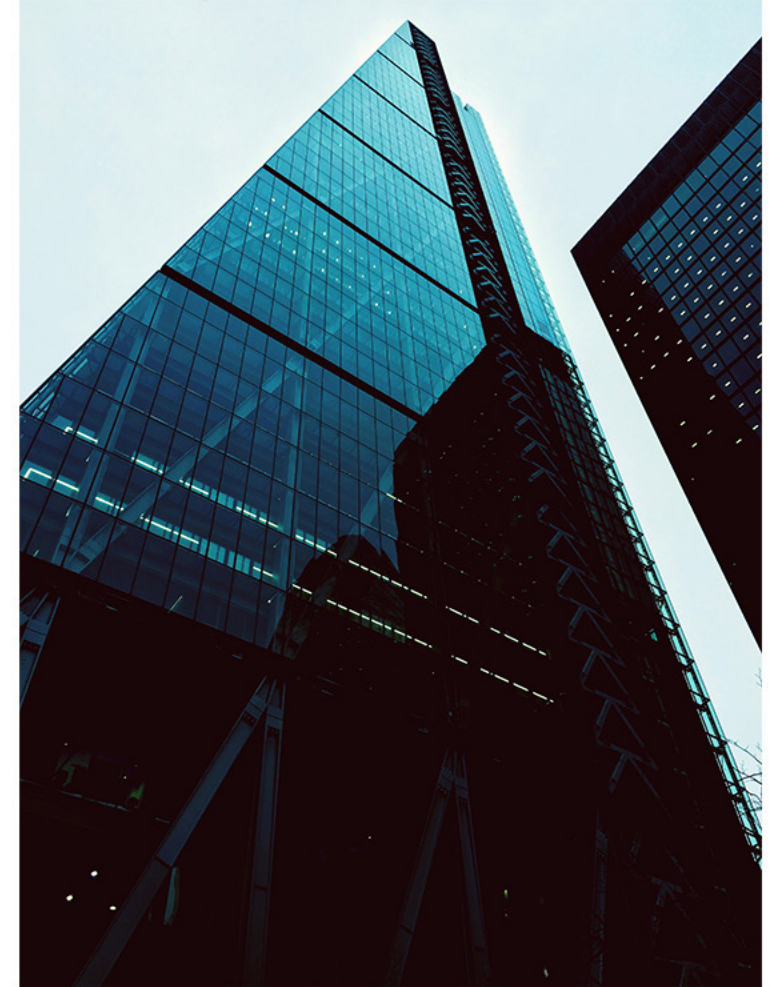

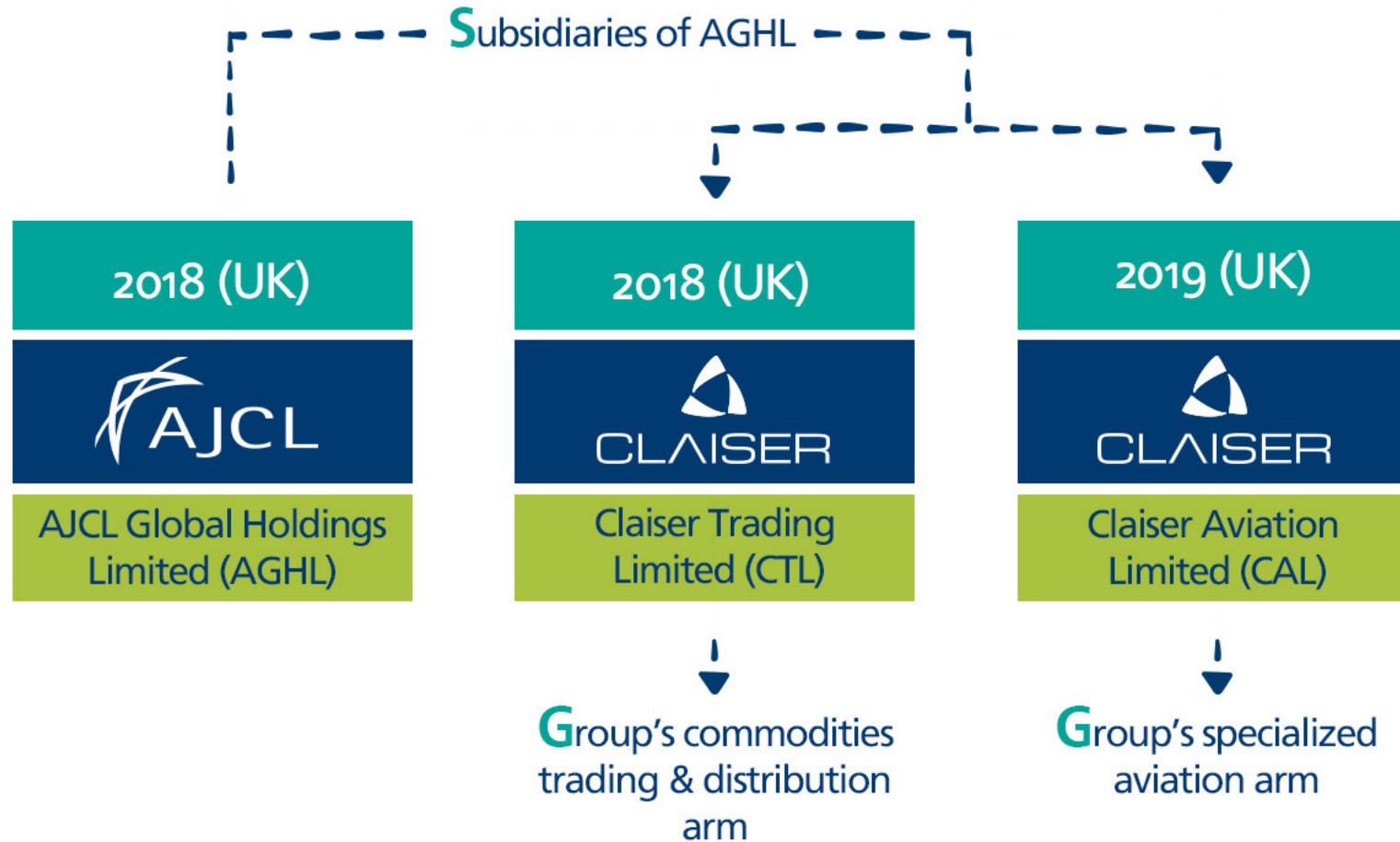
requirements in this field, a dedicated company was deemed necessary to hold the groups aviation related distribution agreements and manage the provision of technical services.

Group Structure



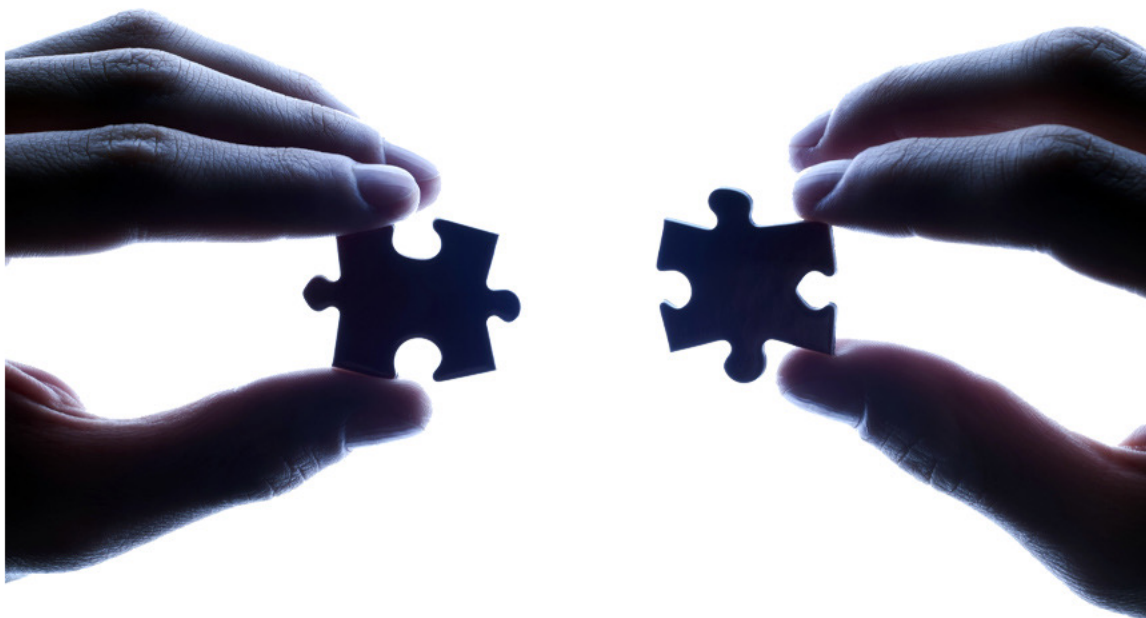
Global Presence
